Class Text

- Ask and answer questions

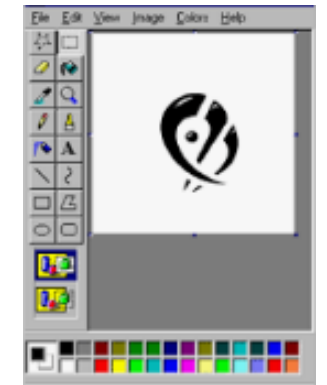
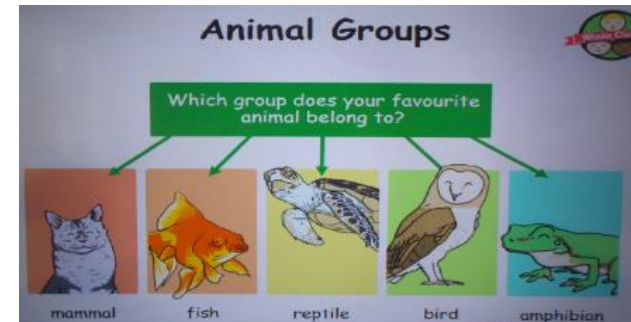

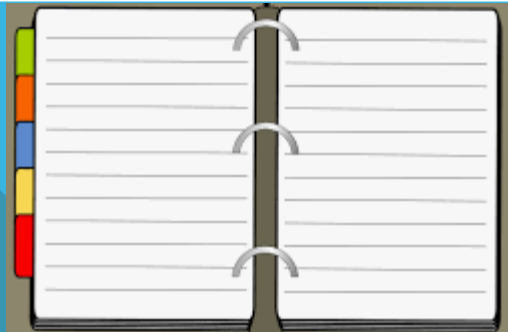


Homework
