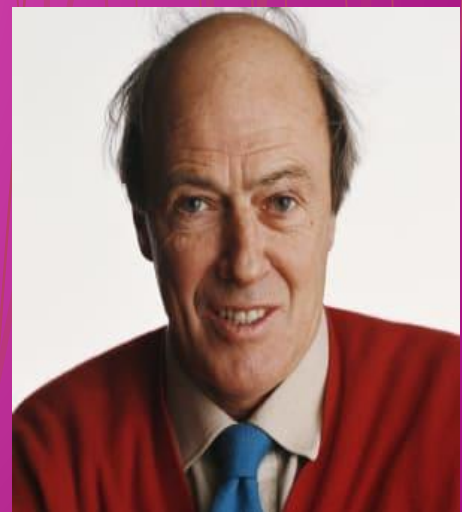
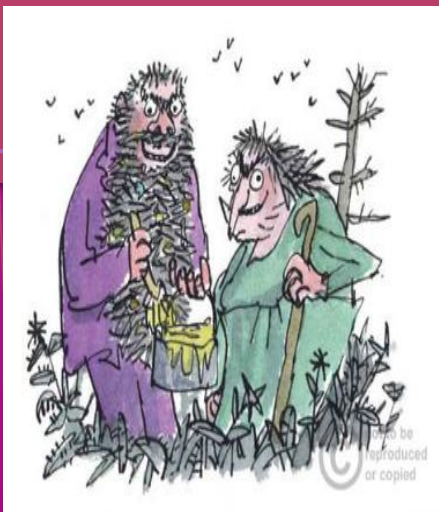

Talk to your child about what they are reading.

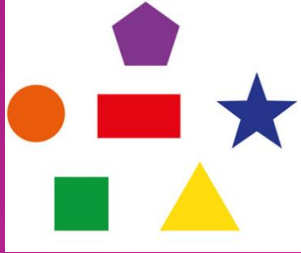
Questions you could use are:

How can you help?

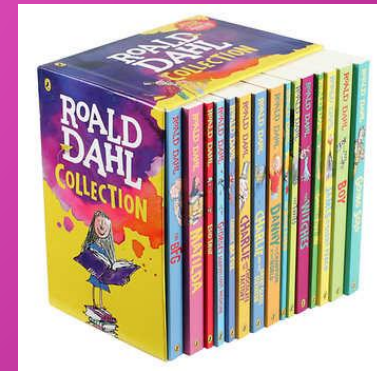
Identify and discuss forces of nature that affects the growth of plants around you. When shopping, discuss the various fruit you buy and which country it grows in due to the climate.



Computing

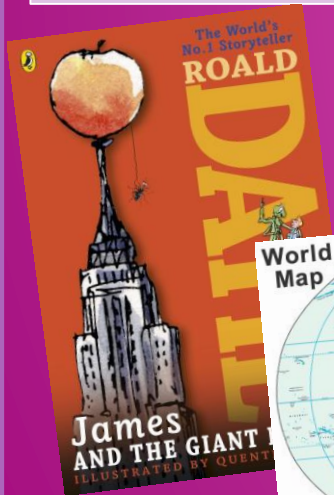


In Computing, we will be becoming presenters, creating a presentation about our favourite Roald Dahl book, using animations, different font styles and backgrounds.



Geography

In Geography, we will be exploring geography of the world based on the tale of James and the Giant Peach. Children will map out the journey taken in the story on maps as well as plan and map out their own journey across Europe inspired by the book. Children will look at the man made and natural geography of the countries they choose to travel to, and explore James' final destination of New York.



Art & DT

In Art, we will be focusing on the illustrator Quentin Blake. We will be creating sketches of ourselves in the style of his illustrations. We will be designing and making our own dream bags inspired by The BFG.

Music

Children will continue to create their own class song and learn to play Ode Joy on the recorder.

PE



In PE, we will be will be developing our skills in athletics in preparation for Sports Day. We will also be going swimming on a weekly basis.

French

In French, we will be introducing vocabulary about the home, looking at particular rooms, as well as consolidating language already learnt.



RE

Our topic this term is: Sikhism – Prayer and Worship. We will be learning to understand different ways that Sikhs show their commitment to God and comparing their practices in order to explore which shows the most commitment.



PSHE

In PSHE, we will be looking at how we and our bodies are special, as well as having specific HRSE lessons about the human body.
