We use The White Rose Maths Scheme of Learning alongside other material.




Assessment

In Science we will be learning about the life of William Beaumont and his contribution to medical science specifically the digestive system. Alongside this, we will be investigating how the digestive system works.






How can you help?

Computing

In Computing, we will be coding using code.org. The children will be completing projects and using skills such as debugging.



History

In History, we will be using primary and secondary resources to learn about the life and times of Ancient Greeks.

We will look at timelines to place the period, research and compare city states, learn about Greek Gods and find out when and where the Olympic games began.



Art

In Art, we will be researching Greek pots. We will use our Sketch Books to collect and record ideas and work towards a final piece using the technique of modelling using clay.



Music

In Music, we will be continuing to learn to play the recorder. We will also be looking at a variety of theme tunes and composing our own.
